

A RECIPROCAL COURSE TO COURSE ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between

Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology (SIAST)

And

Briercrest College and Seminary

This is a reciprocal transfer credit agreement which provides for recognition of selected courses completed by students at SIAST (Business Certificate Program) and at Briercrest College and Seminary.

Students from the SIAST Business Certificate Program and from Briercrest College and Seminary who have successfully completed the following courses within the past five years will be assigned transfer credit from the other institution as detailed in the following table.

* To receive transfer credit for the SIAST courses BCOM 120 and BCOM 121, the Briercrest College and Seminary course BU201 must be taken prior to or concurrent with BU 213.

This agreement will allow Briercrest College and Seminary students who have successfully completed one or more of the aforementioned courses to use individual courses toward the admission requirements of the SLAST diploma programs in Accountancy, Business Administration, Financial Services, Business Human Resources or Business Marketing, as applicable.

Terms of the Agreement:

1. The implementation of this agreement will commence for students entering the above courses in September 2007 and will continue thereafter for five years.
2. It is the responsibility of each party to inform the other of any substantive changes that may impact this articulation in any way. This includes but is not limited to changes in course curriculum, course numbering, program components and/or requirements.
3. Representatives from both institutions will discuss the terms of a renewal at least six months prior to the natural termination of this articulation agreement.
4. Implementation of this agreement will be through registration services at each institution.


