



Married Student Discount Application Form

Each year Briercrest College and Seminary provides a number of scholarships for its student families. Discounts are for tuition only. To be eligible, a student must meet the academic requirements of Briercrest College and Seminary, pass all courses, complete the entire semester requirements, and meet the conditions as listed below. Employees eligible for the employee scholarship program may not apply for both the married student discount and the employee scholarship.

- Spouses of full-time students will be offered a 40% reduction in the tuition costs per semester. This discount is awarded to the student with the least tuition cost providing they pay tuition. Does not include tuition paid from agencies.
- Full-time is defined as being registered for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester in the College and 9 credit hours per semester in the Seminary.
- Distance Learning courses may be used to maintain full-time status. Distance Learning courses may only be used in the semester it was taken out to maintain full-time status.
- Discounts are awarded to on-campus or Briercrest Distance Learning tuition only. Individual music lessons do not qualify.
- Discounted Distance Learning courses must be **completed in the semester in which they were taken out.**
- Audited courses do not qualify for this discount.
- This is a taxable benefit- T4A.
