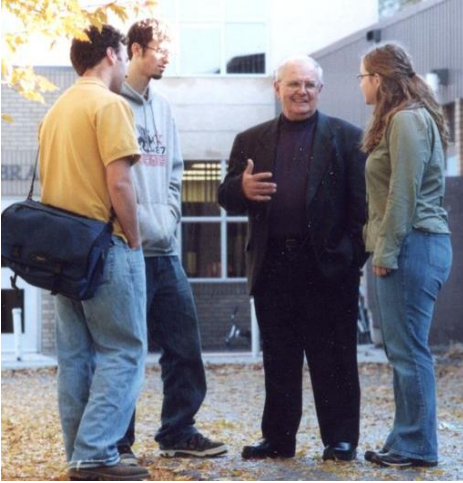


In Prayer for Briercrest
