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1. General Admissions

Admission Deadlines: Nov 30th for next Fall (Aug/Sept)
April 30th - for next Winter (Jan/Feb)



2. Counselling Admissions Documents

Applicants moving forward will be required to submit:

1. Short answer questions
2. Resume and photo
3. Criminal record check no more than 6 months old
4. Three detailed letters of reference from a friend, colleague, and ministry supervisor
5. **Certificate in Counselling applicants only:** Research paper, APA style, 3-5 pages



3. Group Interview and Response Paper

- Applicants moving forward will participate in a group interview. The counselling team will share information about the counselling programs and invite interaction with applicants.
- Following the interview, applicants will submit a 2-3 page written response.



4. Individual Interview

Applicants moving forward will participate in a short individual interview with counselling faculty.



5. Results

Successful applicants will be offered a seat in the program.

- Those who applied by Nov. 30th, will receive admissions acceptance emails in March. These students can begin their studies in our summer semester (Apr.) taking core courses (Biblical Studies, Theology, and Christian Ministry), they will take their first counselling course CO603 in Fall (Aug.)
- Those who applied by Apr. 30th, will receive admissions acceptance emails in July. These students can begin their studies in our fall semester (Aug.) taking core courses (Biblical Studies, Theology, and Christian Ministry), they will take their first counselling course CO603 in Winter (Jan/Feb)
